

Plumsteadville Inn Alcohol Service Policies

Thank you for choosing the Plumsteadville Inn to host your special occasion. Our goal is for everyone to be safe and to have a good time. Below are some of our policies to ensure the safety of everyone here at the Plum.

*Underage drinking will not be permitted whatsoever. Any guest who appears 30 years of age or younger will be required to provide a valid photo ID (PA state law). Valid forms of ID include: Driver's License, State-issued Identification Card, Military ID Card and Passport. No other forms of ID will be accepted nor will copies of any of the listed accepted forms. A valid ID may not be expired; if it is expired it is not valid. As per PA state law, anyone who is asked to provide ID and cannot present it will not be allowed to consume alcohol. Any person who is underage or has been asked for & does not have ID who is seen consuming alcohol by the Plumsteadville Inn staff will be asked to leave the property immediately. If anyone refuses to leave once they have been asked to, law enforcement will be contacted. Also, any person who is seen giving alcohol to minors or to someone who could not provide ID once asked will also be asked to leave.

*Outside alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited in any of the dining areas, parking lots, bars or outside seating. The only place outside alcoholic beverages are permitted are inside of the hotel rooms.

*The Plumsteadville Inn reserves the right to breathalyze-test any minor who may be suspected of drinking anywhere on premises or if the minor appears visibly intoxicated upon arrival. Any minor found with alcohol in his or her system will be asked to leave immediately – no exceptions.

*We have a strict three shot limit per person. A person may consume other alcoholic beverages in addition to the three shots, however, no one may have more than three shots before, during or after any party.

*As per PA state law, any person who appears visibly intoxicated will not be served alcoholic beverages. Even if the guest is staying overnight at the inn, PA law does not allow us to serve any person who appears visibly intoxicated.

*The Plumsteadville Inn reserves the right to cut off alcohol service at any time if guests become too intoxicated or do not follow these policies. No refund will be issued if the bar is shut down early due to any issues related to the above policies.
